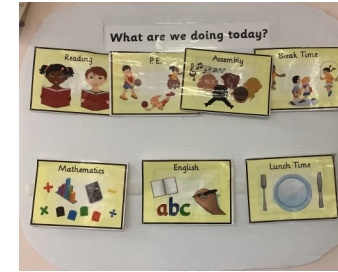

AS1 base (Reception - Year 3)



Rec—Y3 children are taught in the AS1 base.

There are 8 children supported by 5 adults.

We have a sensory room within the base.

Children follow the National Curriculum and engage in whole-school approaches such as Read Write Inc, but often on a 1-1 basis.

There are opportunities for child-initiated activities throughout the day and access to the Early Years outdoor area.



Y3—Y6 children are taught in the AS2 base.

There are 8 children supported by 4 adults.

We have a quiet room within the base and direct access to an outdoor area.

Children continue to follow the National Curriculum. They often work in small groups, and will all engage in learning at the same time.

There are opportunities for children to join activities with the mainstream classes where appropriate—for example, playtimes and P.E.
